GRADE RR & GRADE R:


Will be in Teacher supervised waiting area (sandpit area) from 13:00 to 13:30 whereafter they will be handed over to Aftercare and will be entered into the Aftercare register at 14:20.

GRADE 1 TO GRADE 3:

Will be in Teacher supervised waiting class from 13:00 to 13:30. Children will then go to supervised waiting class under the shade netting from 13:30 until 14:00.

GRADE 4 TO GRADE 7:

Will be in a supervised waiting area under the shade netting until 14:00.



- All children from Grade 1 to Grade 7 will go to the waiting area, and then Aftercare from 14:00.
- No child (Gr. 1 to Gr. 7) is allowed to wait down on the field or in the car park for their transport.
- Every child needs to be fetched personally – no hooting for children. This rule will be strictly enforced for safety reasons. Please inform your transport company of this rule.
- Should your child be involved in an extra mural, they are to go to Aftercare and not wait at the school gate to be collected.


