## Dear Parents

As we approach the end of 2019 and reflect on the year so far, as a board of directors we are humbled and deeply grateful to God for His provision for The King's School West Rand. In every way his provision is not just sufficient, but abundant - in our facilities, staff, pupils and parents. Parents, thank you for your support for the school and most especially for trusting us to partner with you in the education of your children. We are passionate about our Vision - Excellence in education to the Glory of God! We are mindful that there are many options of private schools available in the area and so are particularly conscious of the responsibility that we have to educate your children, not only to pass with an excellent matric result, but to equip them to be young men and women of character who will be nation-changers to the Glory of God.

It is with great excitement that we now timetable swimming into our program. We believe that learning to swim is not just a nice-to-have opportunity in education but an essential life skill and we give God all the praise for the blessing of our swimming pool. We continue to seek God's direction in all aspects regarding the school - academics, sport, extra-murals and spiritual formation. Our desire is never to let our own agendas get in the way of God's agenda for The King's School West Rand - we echo the words of the Psalmist in Psalm 127:1 "Unless the Lord builds the house, they that labour do so in vain."

As a Board of Directors, we are very cognisant of the fact that everyone is struggling to make ends meet in our current recessionary environment. By prudent management of next year's budget and cutting back on some expenses, we have been able to limit the fee increase to 5,1% on average.

We also know that having multiple siblings in the school is a serious drain on the household budget, and so we have increased the discount for two children families from R600 to R800 (a 33% increase) and for three children families from R1000 to R1300 (a 30% increase).

Our school offers the highest discount in the region on fees paid in advance, 9% for fees paid annually in advance before 31 January 2020. For 3-month or 6-month advance payment there are also discounts available, but these are only applicable if the account is up to date and not in arrears.

It is our desire that Christian education be as affordable to as many families as possible, may God grant it be so.




