Has it become more difficult to be a parent than it was for previous generations? I think undoubtedly it is more difficult now because never before in history have we had a generation that has experienced more radical and rapid changes than this generation of parents. Our children are growing up in a world that is remarkably different to the one we experienced as children, and we don't have the luxury of standing on the shoulders of a previous generation for lessons on how to parent in a transformed world.

Matt Fuller, of the Gospel Coalition, provides some sound biblical advice to parents in his article 'How to raise children in a 'be yourself' world' (Click the link on https://www.thegospelcoalition.org /article/raise-children-be-yourselfworld/ to read his advice). He tells us that "the world" in the biblical sense is secular culture and is, and always has been, hostile to God's truth. He reminds us that the basics of parenting are still the same: love your children, do not exasperate them, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

Our children will battle to grasp the better path of self-denial that the Bible teaches if they are only exposed to a culture that teaches radical self-expression and self-enrichment. As parents, we need to faithfully model this better path ourselves. Fuller says we need to make sure our kids hear stories of costly faithfulness and joy persuading them with the truth rather than just telling them the truth.

Parents, I am praying that God provides you with all the wisdom that you need as you remain steadfast in proclaiming,

"as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord".


