# From the Principal's desk



It's the month of June, exam season in many schools. I always feel compassion for our students in this time, because many of them experience such anxiety over exams.

As parents, there are a few things we can do to help.

1. Assist your kids to draw up a study timetable for this month. Being organised in this way will relieve some stress.
2. Speak to your children about stress. Some stress is motivating stress; other stress is paralysing stress. Our self-talk in paralysing stress is important, we should not be telling ourselves doom prophecies.
3. Your student needs a quiet place to study, preferably at a desk, and distractions (like cell-phones) should be removed.
4. Early preparation is important. Help your child not to procrastinate and 'cram' for exams.
5. It often helps a child if a parent can quiz them from their study notes. This builds confidence to fight assessment anxiety.
6. Routines are important. When kids are studying, they should arrange study sessions of not more than 45 minutes, followed by a rest period of 10-15 minutes walking around and getting some fresh air. Children should be disciplined in sticking to such schedules.
7. Pray with your child over their studies for the Lord to enable them to retain what they study so that they can give a good account of themselves in exams.

And I will pray for you as parents. Because we know that when kids write exams, parents also have stress.


## AFC Bournemouth – Soccer Clinic held on Friday 03 June 2022:
