

## A Shine That Went Beyond Shoes

When Shaan Shuta and Talia Magesh knelt down on the dusty ground of Twelopele Masakane Primary School, cracked shoes in their hands and polish staining their fingertips, they didn't realise they were about to learn one of life's most powerful lessons, that true leadership begins with humility.

The prefects weren't armed with speeches or donations, but with polish, brushes, and cloths. Their goal was to shine the worn school shoes of learners who could not afford new ones.

At first, the children watched shyly as the older students knelt before them, gently scrubbing away layers of dirt and tying broken shoelaces. But soon, laughter rippled



through the air as the prefects joked and chatted with the learners and staff, breaking down barriers one shoe at a time. What began as an act of service turned into a morning of shared joy.

"When I saw their faces light up after we cleaned their shoes, I felt something change inside me," said Talia with excitement. "It wasn't just about shiny shoes. It was about showing them that they are seen, valued, and loved; that even the smallest act can whisper, 'You matter."

The prefects learnt that kindness doesn't need to be grand to be meaningful. We often think leadership means standing in front, but sometimes, it's about kneeling down — lifting others up with our hands, not just our words.

By the end of the day, rows of shoes gleamed in the sunlight, and so did the smiles of children who felt cared for. The prefects left with polish-stained hands but transformed hearts. For most, the experience was more than community service, it was the moment they discovered that the power to lead begins with the courage to serve.


